Printer Update: Amy set up a program that allows papers to be folded using the printer. A few remaining issues need to be resolved, after which newsletters will be printed in-house. Internet Comparisons: Information from other companies is being reviewed to explore faster internet options, including costs and packages. The current internet speed at the center is quite slow.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Advertising Opportunity: Carol G. spoke with Sarah H. from WCMP Radio. Sarah shared several great ideas for advertising the center. COMMITTEES Fundraising: The Fall Craft Fair is filling up quickly with crafters. One table is still available. Safety Committee: An update was provided regarding the capacity of three rooms and the installation of a new fire extinguisher. Board Member Responsibilities: No changes were reported.

**ACTIVITIES:** Potluck: 53 attendees; \$97.60 in donations. Exercise: Going well. Games: Games are going well. Music: Going well. Movie Day: Attendance is steady. More people are encouraged to join for movies, snacks, and laughter. The next movie day is scheduled for October 14 at 1:30 PM.


